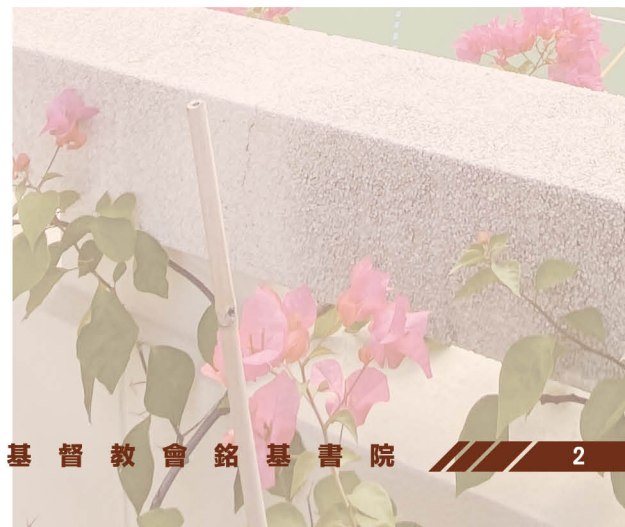

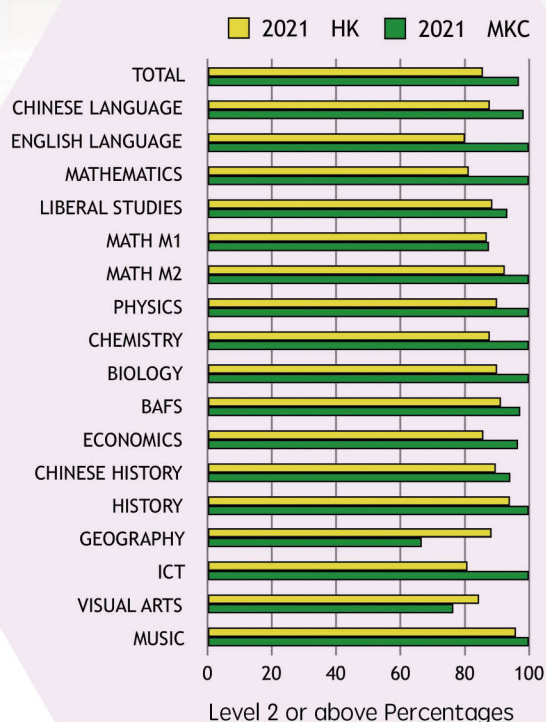

HKDSE Results

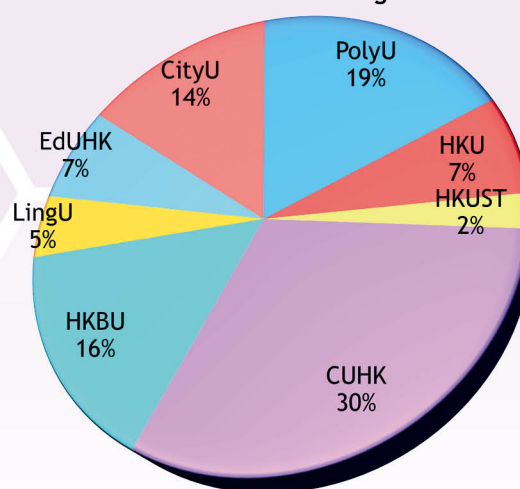
118 S.6 students sat for the HKDSE examination in 2021. The average percentage of all subjects that achieved level 2 or above was 96.8%.

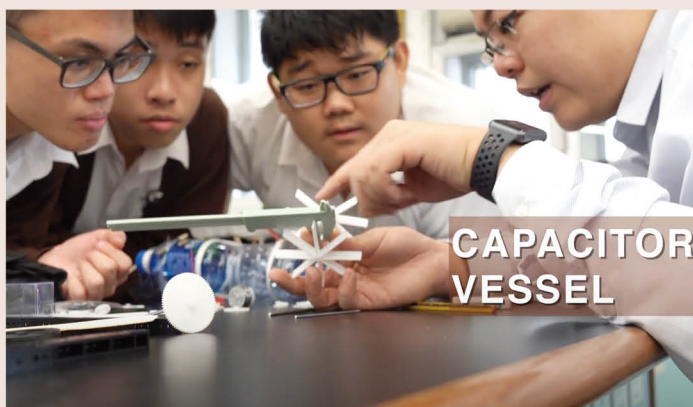
