


113 S.6 students sat for the HKDSE examination in 2023. The average percentage of all subjects that achieved **level 2 or above** was **96%**.

Soybean is one of the most important crops in human history. Through the lens of Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, Geography, History and Economics, soybean offers a holistic view of our society's

foundation and prospects. By exploring the many facets of this wonder crop, our junior form students embarked on a multi-disciplinary journey.


